Book Of Allah (AL QURAN AL KARIM or The Holy Quran) The Quran (Arabic ????????, al-Qur??n, \"the recitation\") is the sacred text of Islam . For Muslims, it takes verbatim the word of God (Allah). This book is to this day the first and oldest authentic literary document known in Arabic; Muslim tradition presents it as the first work in Arabic, with the specific character of inimitability in beauty and in ideas. For Muslims, the Koran groups together the words of God, revelations (?y?t) made to the last prophet and messenger of God Muhammad (????, Mu?ammad, \"the praised\") from 610-612 until his death in 632 by 1' archangel Gabriel (?????, jibril). The Koran is sometimes called simply al-kit?b (\"the Book\"), adh-dhikr (\"the Reminder\") or al-furq?n (\"the Discernment\"). In this sense, it is, for Muslims, the expression of an uncreated attribute of God addressed to the intention of all humanity .

Tripping with Allah

If Tripping with Allah is a road book, it's a road book in the tradition of 2001: A Space Odyssey, rather than On the Road. Amazonian shamanism meets Christianity meets West African religion meets Islam in this work of reflection and inward adventure. Knight, the "Hunter S. explores Islam and drugs, but also Knight's own process of creativity and discovery.

I want you to know this is real.\"—Muhammad Ali, June 14, 1976, The Tonight Show On June 26, 1976, Muhammad Ali fought in a mixed-rules contest against iconic pro wrestling champion Antonio Inoki for the so-called \"martial arts championship of the world.\" Broadcast from Tokyo to a potential audience of 1.4 billion in 34 countries, the spectacle foreshadowed and, in many ways, led to the rise of mixed martial arts as a major sport. The unique contest was controversial and panned by wrestling and boxing supporters alike, but the real action was behind the scenes. Egos, competing interests, and a general sense of apprehension over what would happen in the ring led to hodgepodge rules thrown together at the last minute. Bizarre plans to \"save\" Ali if the fight got out of hand were even concocted. In Ali vs. Inoki, author Josh Gross gets inside Ali's head leading up to the match by resurrecting pre-fight interviews. Gross also introduces us to Inoki, the most famous face in Japan who was instrumental in shaping modern mixed martial arts.

The Burh?n

In The Burh?n Mohammad Hijab analyses Ibn S?n?'s argument for the existence of God. Regards as being most invulnerable to any type of counterattack, Ibn S?n?'s Burh?n argument postulates that a world with only contingent existences is inconceivable, as a contingent existence cannot cause itself. Ibn S?n? argues that the only way to explain the existence of anything is to postulate the existence of a uncaused necessary being, or a w?jib al-wuj?d ('necessary existence'). However, despite its impact, the Burh?n has not been packaged for apologetic use for a modern audience. Hijab's novel contribution to the discourse surrounding God's existence is found in his re-articulation of this argument for theists attempting to make the case for religion to atheist audiences. Using the Burh?n as his guide, Hijab provides his own proofs for the necessary existence of God and answers some of the most prominent objections. Hijab applies the arguments for a necessary being by referring to potential pastoral and apologetic settings using two fictitious characters, Richard and Betty.
